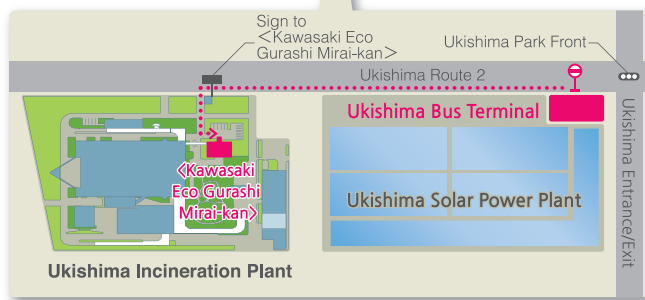
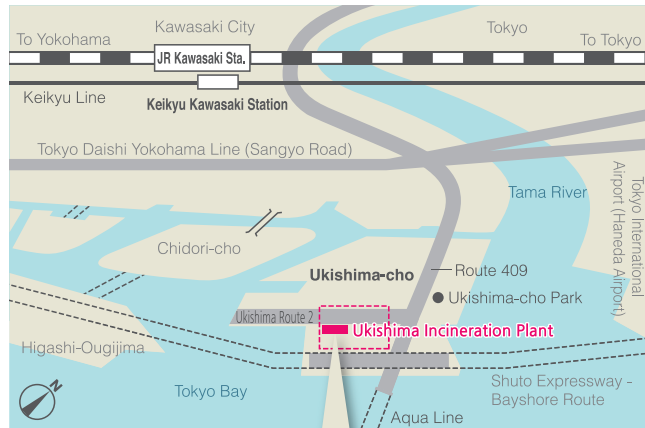


Kawasaki Mega Solar Power Generation Plant

Kawasaki Mega Solar Power Generation Plant, which is composed of two solar power plants in Ukishima and Ogishima area and has a power generation capacity of 20,000kw, is a joint project between Kawasaki-city and Tokyo Electric Power Company.

The solar power generation is equal to an annual energy consumption of approximately 5,900 households.

***Ukishima Solar Power Plant can be seen from the Observation Space adjacent to the <Kawasaki Eco Gurashi Mirai-kan>.** (Reservation required)



Access

From JR Kawasaki Station Take the Kawasaki City Bus 03 Waterfront District going to "Ukishima Bus Terminal", and get off at the last stop, "Ukishima Bus Terminal" (Approx. 40 min)

From Kisarazu Station Take the "Kawasaki-Kisarazu Line (via Aqua Line)" and get off at "Ukishima Bus Terminal" (Approx. 35 min)

*Approx. 10 min walk from the Ukishima Bus Terminal 800m from "Kawasaki-Ukishima Exit" on the Shuto Expressway Bayshore Route

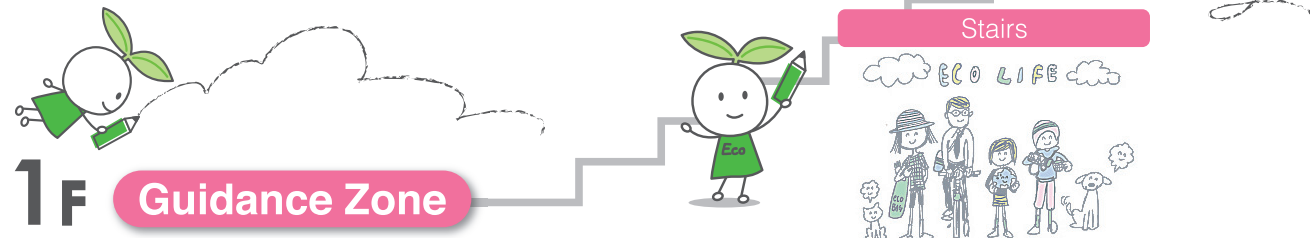

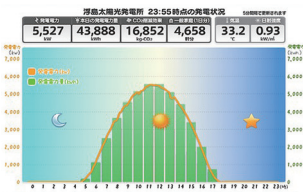
